### 2010 CHUCK STEIN SERIES for PHRF and ONE DESIGN

Saturday, April 24th and Saturday, July 17th in Marina del Rey

The April 24th Race is an Inverted Start Race where boats handicaps are taken at their start for a 10nm course. July 17th Races are standard course chart races. This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the PHRF, Americap, and /or One-Design class rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions and any Amendments and Notices issued by the Race Committee.

Expected classes are PHRF A, B and C; Schock 35, J80, Martin 242, and 5.70 Sportboats.

A minimum of three boats establish a class. July 17th races will be run together with MVYC's Dr. Robert Baker Regatta and post-race festivities will be held at Marina Venice Yacht Club.

One-Design Classes must have a representative contact PMYC Race Committee at (310) 823-9717 no later than Tuesday, April 20th to be recognized as a class.

Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA and US Sailing, and racing a boat that is registered in the class or fleet in which it competes.

Entries should be received by Friday, April 23, 2010 at 7:30 PM. Entry fee is \$15 per race for US Sailing members; \$18 for non-members or \$25 for the series. Late entries will be accepted up to 0900 on race day. Checks should be made payable to PMYC, and be at 13915 Panay Way, Marina del Rey, 90292 by the deadline. Please join us for Inverted Start trophies and hospitality after the race.

Sailing Instructions will be available at PMYC no later than 7:30 PM on Friday, April 23, 2010.

First warning will be at **1150 hours** for the Inverted Start race.

Courses will be chosen from Marina Del Rey Course Chart 16 unless otherwise stated at the skippers meeting and will be sailed on the Marina Del Rey Olympic Circle Course outside the MDR Breakwater.

Low Point Scoring System with no throw outs will be used. Please refer to Sailing Instructions for Ties.

Trophies for the Series will be awarded following the last race on Sunday, July 17, 2010.

In consideration of your acceptance of my race entry, I agree as follows: 1) My yacht will be equipped to conform with any USCG safety requirements and those of any fleet or association whose rating system will be used in the race in which I compete. 2) Any contestant or some member of the race or protest committee may inspect my yacht before or after the race. 3) I agree to comply with all rules and sailing instructions regarding the race. 4) I hereby release the club, its officers, agents, employees and committees from any and all liability for any injury to my self or my yacht arising out of their conduct of the race or my use of the facilities, provided that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my yacht. 5) I assume any risk of injury arising out of my participation in the race, failure or breakage of my yacht or any of its equipment, or weather conditions. 6) I acknowledge that the safety and seaworthiness of my yacht is my sole responsibility and PMYC, in accepting my entry, assumes no responsibility therefore. 7) I certify that my crew and I are able to swim. 8) I will notify the Club or race Committee immediately upon withdrawal from the race. 9) I own or have chartered the yacht entered, I am a member of a Yacht Club that belongs to SCYA or to a yacht racing organization that is a member of the USSA or a current member in good standing of the one design class association in which I am racing.
